PRACTICAL INFO FOR THE MEETING

1. How to reach Monte Sant'Angelo from Bari (the Wojtyla Airport)

- **By BUS:** There are several ways to reach Monte Sant'Angelo from the main Italian cities by bus. Among these we point out:

 - * **SAPS National and International Lines:** in this case, we arrive to Foggia, to then use other local lines (Ferrovie del Gargano and SITA) up to Monte Sant'Angelo.

- **By CAR:** To get to Monte Sant'Angelo by car, you must reach the A14 Bologna / Taranto motorway. Continuing on this highway you can take:

 - * the exit for San Severo (Km 57). Merge onto highway 272 towards San Marco in Lamis, continue to San Giovanni Rotondo and 24 km to Monte Sant'Angelo;
 - * the Foggia tollgate exit (Km 54). Turn onto the SS 89 towards Manfredonia, at Macchia, turn off for Monte Sant'Angelo

- **By TRAIN:** To reach Monte Sant'Angelo by train we recommend a stop at the Foggia station. It is possible to consult the flight schedules from the Ferrovie dello Stato website.

 - * Taxi service is available near the train station.

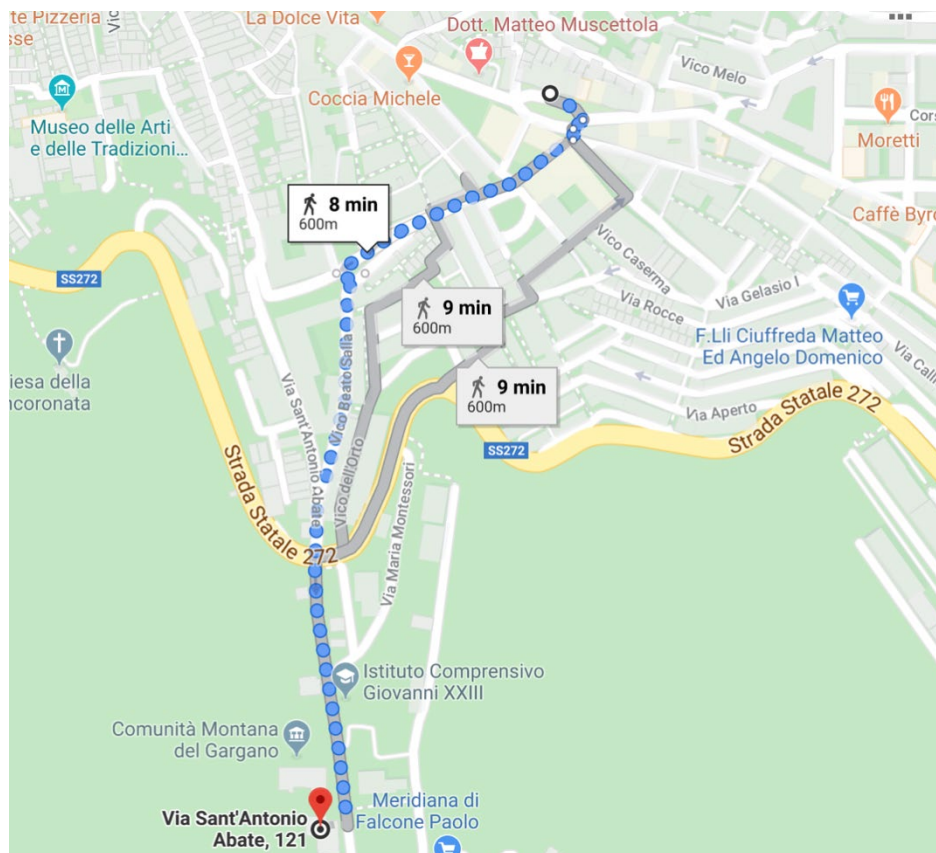
